cp	coupling (This one is not in pinyin; they use English directly.)	cp	For "coupling," which is related to Japanese pop culture. In most cases, it refers to homoerotic relationships. It is commonly used in the Japanese idol industry.	这对 cp 也太可爱了吧 This cp is so adorable!
idol—爱豆	ai-dou	/'aid(ə)l/	The recombination of pinyin (Chinese pronunciation) and English pronunciation. It means a star or a member in an idol group. The term <i>idol</i> originated from Japanese and Korean entertainment circles.	我的爱豆对于我来说是黑暗中的一盏明灯！ To me, my idol is a light in the darkness.
pick-pick	Pick (This one is not in pinyin; just use English directly.)	/pɪk/	The original meaning is "select," but in bullet chats, it means "like and support." It is from <i>Produce 101</i> , a reality television talent competition franchise, based around the formation of a K-pop girl group or boy group. The audience needs to vote for their favorite person to select eleven members to build a new idol group. The voting process is called "pick."	他是我 pick 的人，他是最棒的！ This is the star I picked, he is the best!
